3. Dates of the tournament

5. Events

Boys' (BS) and girls' (GS) singles, boys' (BD) and girls' (GD) doubles and mixed doubles (XD) in each age category.

- U17: players born in 2000 or later
- U15: players born in 2002 or later
- U13: players born in 2004 or later
- U11: players born in 2006 or later

A player can participate in a maximum of three events: one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles. A player is allowed to participate in FIJC/U19 tournament in some event(s) and in U11-



U17 tournament in other event(s). A player may not participate in the same type of event in both tournaments.

In the singles events, preliminary pools of 3 or 4 players will be played. The two best players of each pool will continue to the main draw and the other players will continue to the consolation draw expect in U15 and U17 where only main draw will be played. The main and consolation draws will be played in a knock-out system.

The doubles events will be played in a knock-out system.

In all U13 and U11 events, in both main draw and consolation draw, the players/pairs having lost their semi-final matches will play a bronze-medal match.

The seeding and draw will be done by the organizers and the referee, according to Finnish Junior Elite tour regulations.

The organizer has the right to cancel an event with too few entries, or to combine such an event with the same type of event of an older age group.

6. Scoring - testing best of five games of 11 points system

Finnish International Junior Elite 2016 is testing the new scoring system played with best of five games of 11 points.

For setting maximum of 15 points has been selected. This means at 10-all, the player/pair wins the game when a two points lead is achieved or first to 15 when the score reaches 14-all.

See Figure 1 for details of the scoring system to be tested in the tournament.

7 Scoring System

7.1 A match shall consist of the best of five games

7.2 A game shall be won by the side which first scores 11 points, except as provided in Law 7.3 and 7.4.

7.3 If the score becomes 10-all, the side which gains a two point lead first, shall win the game.

7.4 If the score becomes 14-all, the side scoring the 15th point shall win the game.

8 Change of Ends

8.1.2 at the end of the second game,

8.1.3 at the end of the third game, if there is to be a fourth game; and

8.1.4 at the end of the fourth game, if there is to be a fifth game; and

8.1.5 in the fifth game when a side first scores 6 points

16. Continuous play, Misconduct & penalties

16.2 Intervals

16.2.1 not exceeding 60 seconds, only in the fifth game, when the leading score reaches 6 pointsand

16.2.2 not exceeding 60 seconds between the first and second games, second and third games, third and fourth games, and fourth and fifth games shall be allowed in all matches.

Figure 1: Experimental laws for testing scoring systems. The experimental laws stated here are only those sections that are different than the current laws as per the respective sections of the Handbook II, Section 1A – Laws of Badminton.



7. Brand of shuttlecocks

RSL shuttlecocks will be used in the tournament.

8. Clothing and advertising

FIJC will be conducted according to the BWF Regulations 19-23 on advertising and clothing.

9. Entries

Entry closing date: Friday, October 14th, 2016 18:59 (GMT +03:00)

Entries must be made either directly by a player's club of which the player/pair is a member or must be accompanied by written authorization from the club of which the player/pair is a member.

- Finnish registrations: through [GoodMinton](#) entry system.

The entries shall be made in order of strength and in national ranking order in each event.
Players' date of birth is also required.

10. Entry fees & payments

Entry fees for the tournament are (shuttles included):

- EUR 36,00 per player in singles events
- EUR 42,00 euros per pair in doubles events (21,00 Eur/player)

Payment of the entry fees

The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn by the withdrawal deadline mentioned above.

It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer. Alternatively, the entry fees can be paid in cash before the first match.

If the entry fee is not paid in time, the player will not be allowed to start the match.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member Association. Organizers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year.
